

City of Bel Aire Utility Advisory Committee Minutes

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tenbrink at 12:00 PM.
2. Roll Call: present –Moss, Broyles, Wynn, Watkins and Tenbrink. Also, in attendance were Public Works Director and City Engineer Anne Stephens.
