

City of Bel Aire Utility Advisory Committee Minutes
Wednesday, September 9, 2020

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tenbrink at 3:00 PM.
2. Roll Call: present Markley, Moss, Broyles, Wynn and Tenbrink. Also, in attendance were Public Works Director and City Engineer Anne Stephens, and Tristin Terhune Bel Aire City HR and Communication Director join the meeting later.
